A central component of participation is gender equality in all decision-making instances. Special attention should also be given to the actual water resource user groups that in the end have to deal with the resulting water management decisions and practices. Many water-related inequalities are due to power relations. By working together in partnerships, more wide-ranging and accepted impacts can be achieved. ¶
